MILLBROOK BUSINESS NAMED AS ONLY ALABAMA ADOBE AUTHORIZED TRAINING CENTER
Located in the city of Millbrook, the newly established Millbrook Office Support & Training Center (MOSTC) has separated itself from its competition by becoming the only Adobe Authorized Training Center in Alabama. As the Adobe Authorized Training Center, MOSTC will offer world-renowned artists and instructors to Central Alabama and the entire state.

MOSTC provides instructor-led training for Adobe and Microsoft software products and a host of other technology-related custom courses. Starting in August, MOSTC will bring instructors from around the country to teach different levels of classes, to include custom courses for Adobe and Microsoft. They have associated themselves with graphic artists, video editors, and web developers, who have achieved Adobe's highest level of certification, most having many different certifications.

"We will bring in instructors who are not only incredible instructors but incredible writers, artists, and more" says Dennis Tomlin, owner of MOSTC. Two instructors in particular bring more than 50 years of design experience and hold 9 different certifications in Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, and Acrobat to name a few.

In August, Bill Cardberry will teach an Advanced Photoshop CS3 course. He is currently preparing for a rarely obtained 5th Adobe certification.

In October, Stacey Cates will teach an Advanced Photoshop CS3 course, along with a photo retouching course. Stacey is currently co-authoring the Adobe Photoshop CS4 Bible in preparation for the release of Adobe's Photoshop CS4.

MOSTC will additionally offer community-based courses to help parents, seniors, and others learn how to use their computer. Courses will teach image and video sharing, video conferencing, basic computing skills and more.
